



Program-Directed Loan Funds

Abecassis Small Business Loan Fund (est. 2002) Loans for Jewish entrepreneurs over the age of thirty who are starting a new business.

American Dream Loan Fund (est. 2005)

Assists immigrants with closing costs and emergency repair expenses associated with the purchase of a first-time home in the Los Angeles area.

Max & Anna Baran, Ben & Sarah Baran & Milton Baran Small Business Loan Fund (est. 1992) Provides loans to new Jewish immigrants to jumpstart a business.

Newton D. & Rochelle F. Becker Graduate Student Loan Fund (est. 1994) Loans for Jewish full-time graduate students to supplement existing financial aid.

Newton D. & Rochelle F. Becker Israel Experience Loan Fund (est. 1995)

An opportunity for teenagers to visit Israel with a summer program and for students to study in Israel.

Brandman Foundation Loan Fund for Nursing Students (est. 2007)

Loans to nursing students of all faiths.

Fund (est. 2002) Loans for Jewish full-time graduate students receiving degrees in medicine.

Morris Doberne Campership Experience Loan Fund (est. 1996)

Assists families sending their children to Jewish sleep-away camp.

Emergency Loan Fund

The heart of the agency since 1904, this fund provides assistance on a non-sectarian basis for urgent needs such as housing, transportation and subsistence.

First-time Home Buyers Loan Fund for Jewish Day School

Teachers (est. 2004) Helping teachers with closing costs or emergency repairs.

Roslyn & Katherine Gaines Loan Fund for Hearing Impaired Students (est. 1993)

Ruth & Jack Hirsch Family Art Student Loan Fund (est. 2002)

Established to provide loans to Jewish full-time undergraduate and graduate students receiving degrees in Art, with an emphasis on students attending local art schools.

Iranian Émigré Loan Fund (est. 1989) To assist in the settlement of immigrants from Iran.

Jewish Communal Student Loan Fund (est. 2003)

Provides loans for working graduate students studying for a Master's degree in Jewish Communal service.

Kopelove Family Home Healthcare Loan Fund

(est. 2000) Assists with the expense of short-term home healthcare for patients of all faiths recovering from surgery, illness, stroke or injury.

Kornfeld Accounting Student Loan Fund (est. 2004)

Provides loans to accounting students of all faiths.

La Kretz Small Business Loan Fund (est. 2001)

Provides loans on a non-sectarian basis to establish or expand small businesses.

Lerner Family Adoption Assistance Loan Fund

(est. 1997) Interest-free loans for Jewish adults to adopt a child or to undergo fertility treatments.

Edward Meltzer Student Loan Fund for Undergraduate Students

(est. 1987) Provides loans to Jewish full-time students in a broad range of programs at four-year colleges and universities.

ORT Student Loan Fund Loans for technical students.

(est. 2003) Provides loans to technical and trade school students.
